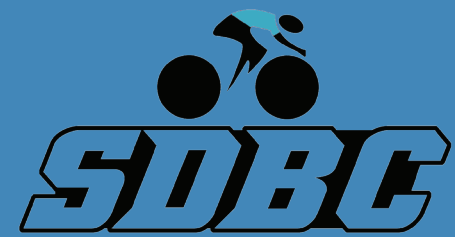

All junior races are SCNCA State Championships, USAC cycling rules apply for championships and all other races.

EQUAL BASE PAYOUT for Men and Women's PRO 1-3. Guaranteed minimum base purse is \$500 for each Men and Women PRO fields (must have a minimum of 5 in field). BONUS PAY for Men & Women PRO 1-3 categories for every rider in each respective field multiply each racer in that field by \$10 and add to base purse.

ENTRY FEES/REGISTRATION:

Pre-registration online at bikereg.com/barrio-logan-grand-prix-2022. All entry fees are nonrefundable and include the \$5.05 USA Cycling insurance and \$.50 SCNCA surcharges. Pre-registration closes **May 11, 10:45 PST**. Race day registration by cash, check, or credit card will incur an additional \$10 late charge. Extra races are \$15 each after paying higher fee. Riders under 18 years are required to have a parent or guardian's signature on the Standard Release Form. Registration opens at 6:15am. All pre-registered riders must sign in 30 minutes prior to event. Valid USA Cycling/UCI license required. Novice (Cat 5) men & women can buy a \$10 1-day license.

RULES:

All 2022 USAC rules apply. Helmets must be worn at all times while you are on your bike. Wheels in/ wheels out, mechanical/wheel pit support provided. Free lap rule applies. Prizes will be presented as soon as time permits at start/finish area. Must be present to receive awards. **Uncollected prizes/cash are deemed forfeited.** UC Continental teams are eligible. Race is held rain or shine.

DIRECTIONS:

Historic Barrio Logan is in downtown San Diego. From I-5 South, take the Cesar Chavez Parkway Exit 14B. Go straight to Beardsley St. and find street parking. From I-5 North exit Cesar Chavez Parkway, turn left and find street parking near Newton Ave. Free parking also available at Cesar Chavez Park. Crit and Registration is on the corner of Newton Ave. and Beardsley St.
