

COURSE: 8.6 miles up legendary Glendora Mountain Road, approximately 2300 feet of climbing, from just above Big Dalton Canyon Rd. to the GMR Summit. Average gradient, 5%.

REGISTRATION: *PRE-REG ONLY*! Registration closes Wed., May 31, 2023 at 11:59pm PDT. *No late registration! No Day-Of registration!*

USACycling licenses required for all entrants. Register online at BikeReg.com.

- START TIMES: Determined by Category Order (see above) and number of Category Entrants. Start times posted by 5:00pm Friday, June 2 at <u>www.lightningvelo.org</u>. First rider off at 8:00am.
- RACE PARKING: Please park legally along Glendora Mountain Road below the start area, or on Big Dalton Canyon Road. No racer parking in lot adjacent to start area! The parking lot is reserved for race volunteers, race sign-in, officials, porta-potties, awards, first aid, and the public.
- DIRECTIONS: From eastbound 210 freeway, exit Grand Ave., turn left, towards mountains. Grand to Sierra Madre Ave., turn right. Sierra Madre to GMR, turn left. Approx. 3/4 of a mile to parking. From westbound 210 freeway, exit Lone Hill, turn right, towards mountains. Lone Hill to Foothill Blvd., turn left. 1/2 mile to Valley Center Ave., turn right. 0.8 miles to Sierra Madre Ave., turn left. Immediate right onto Glendora Mountain Road. Approx. 3/4 mile to race parking.

PLEASE READ: After race sign-in and warm up, please arrive to start line with a minimum of three minutes prior to your start time. Gear rollout required for all junior riders, regardless of category. Report to rollout check near the race start at least ten minutes before your start time. Held under USAC permit and ALL USAC RULES APPLY. Helmets mandatory at all times while on your bike. No fairings or fixed gear bikes allowed. No drafting! Course is on a public road and is open to vehicle traffic. Ride as far to the right of the road as safe. After completing the course, use caution to ride back down to the start area. Never cross the centerline! Times posted and awards presented as soon as possible after last rider has completed the course. No public urination! Please do not litter!
