RULES AND COURSE: USAC category "D" race and all rules apply. The course is 2.0 miles with 102ft climbing out and back course with good asphalt and rolling hills. Event directors have the right to cancel or combined fields depending on field sizes, according to USAC Rules.

EQUAL PAYOUTS for Men's and Women's PRO-1,2,3! Guaranteed minimum base purse is \$1,000 for each Men and Women Fields. BONUS PAY for Men & Women PRO-1-2-3 categories for every rider in each respective field multiply each rider in that field by \$20 and add to base purse.

All other categories top 3 winners Medals & Pay out to cash or prizes, 4th-5th Merch.

REGISTRATION: Opens at 7:00 am and one hour before each scheduled race, closes 10 minutes before each scheduled race time. Same day registration adds **\$15.00 late fee**. We encourage you to register online. We now accept AMEX, MASTER CARD & VISA CREDIT CARDS with a \$4 Service Charge Thanks

Same day waivers must be filled out Online or by racers or parent/legal guardian for anyone 18yrs or younger. **USAC License Required.** Annual licenses available at www.usacycling.org USAC 1-Day Beginner's license: \$15/day, only for Category 5 Men, Women or Juniors. Can be purchased online at www.usacycling.org/events/?state=CA, select appropriate event, and then click on Purchase One-Day License. Bring a receipt to race. USAC 1-Day Experienced license: \$25/day, available to all former USAC Category 1-4 racers. It must be purchased online, prior to the event. All riders must claim prizes before close of day.

FEES: Fees include USAC Insurance and SCNCA Surcharge: **Extra races \$20** must pay higher race fees first.

3. *This is the guaranteed GC prize list: **For the Pro Women & Men, the promoter will adjust the prize list (i.e.: Full field = maximum payout; 75% of field limit = 75% maximum payout, etc.

4. 3. Omnium Bonus Points - Road Race: Points will be awarded as follows: a. 1st place = 5 points, 2nd place = 3 points, 3rd place = 1 point. b. For all categories other than Pro Men 1-3, points will be scored at the line at the finish of laps 3, 5 and 7. c. For Pro Men 1-3 points will be scored at the line at the finish of laps 3, 5, 7 and 9.

4. Omnium Bonus Points – Grand Prix: Points will be awarded as follows: a. 1st place = 5 points, 2nd place = 3 points, 3rd place = 1 point. b. For all categories other than Pro Men 1-3 and Pro Women 1-3, there will be three intermediate points sprints indicated by ringing of the bell at the beginning of the sprint lap. c. For Pro Men 1-3 and Pro Women 1-3, there will be four intermediate points sprints indicated by ringing of the bell at the beginning of the sprint lap.

5. Prizes. Please refer to the Race Announcement for details regarding prizes.

6. General.

- Cat 4/5 Men will race as one category, including for scoring. H 1-5 C 1-5 will also race as one category, including for scoring.
- Masters 50/55+ 1-3 will be scored separately with GC places 5 deep for each category.
- Riders will be provided two bib (body) numbers for placement on each side their torso. Please take care to correctly place the numbers so they are readable by the officials.
- Neutral support for the road race will be provided by Elite Racing Service.
- Results will be accessible on OnTheDay.net. f. Staging for the road race will be on Aerospace Dr. at Phantom West.

g. Feeding during the road race will be allowed for all categories on all laps. Feeding must take place in the Feed Zone at the top of the climb on Phantom West.

h. The centerline rule will be in effect for the entire road race EXCEPT for that portion of the course (the chicane) between Starfighter St. and Nevada Ave. For this portion the entire roadway is rideable. Once on Nevada Ave. the centerline rule is back in place. Chief Referee:
